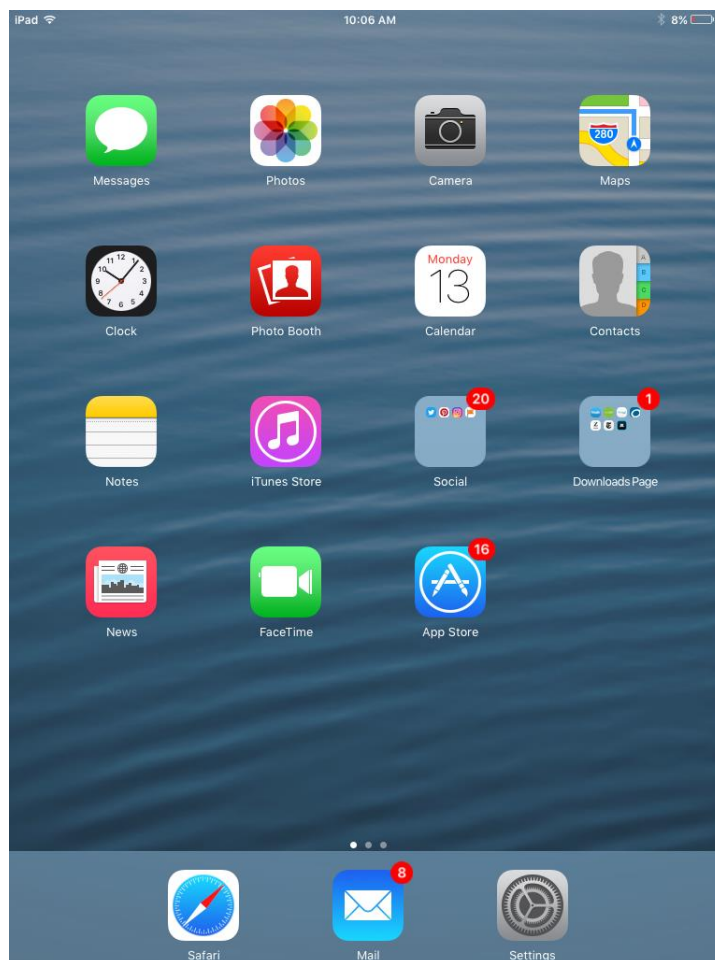

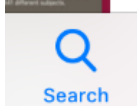

## Getting the App

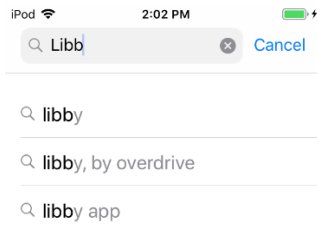
1. Tap the **App Store** icon on your home screen



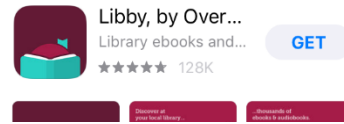
2. Tap Search on the bottom



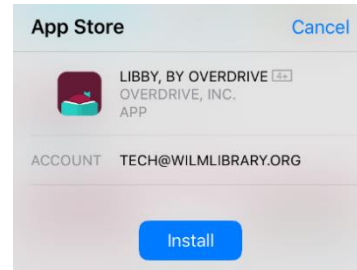
3. Start typing **Libby** and tap then the **libby, by overdrive** result



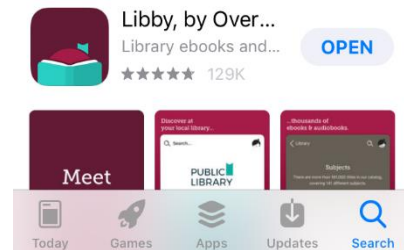
4. Tap the **Get** button next to **Libby**



5. Tap **Install**




6. Tap the **Open** button after it finishes installing

## 1. Tap Yes




Welcome! Thousands of public libraries offer ebooks and audiobooks (for free!) in Libby. Let me ask you a few questions, to guide you to your library.

Note: **Location Services** must be turned on for this to work.

Copy From My Other Device


Otherwise, you can look up your library by name or location.

## 3. Tap This is my Library





If you prefer to read with Kindle, we can open books directly to your Kindle device or Kindle app.

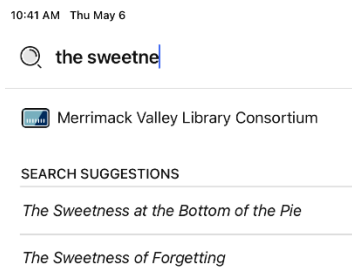

## Borrowing a Book

1. Tap the **magnifying glass** on the **bottom left** of the screen



2. Start typing the **title of a book**
3. When you see the book in the **search suggestions** below, tap the **suggestion**



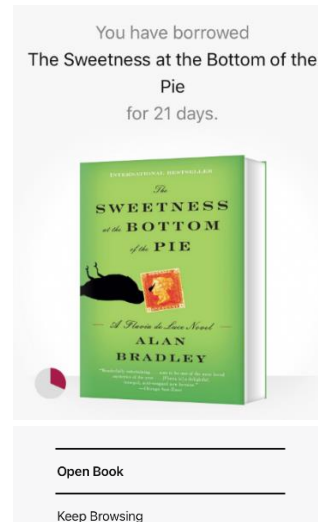
4. Tap **Borrow** next to the **eBook** or the **Audiobook**



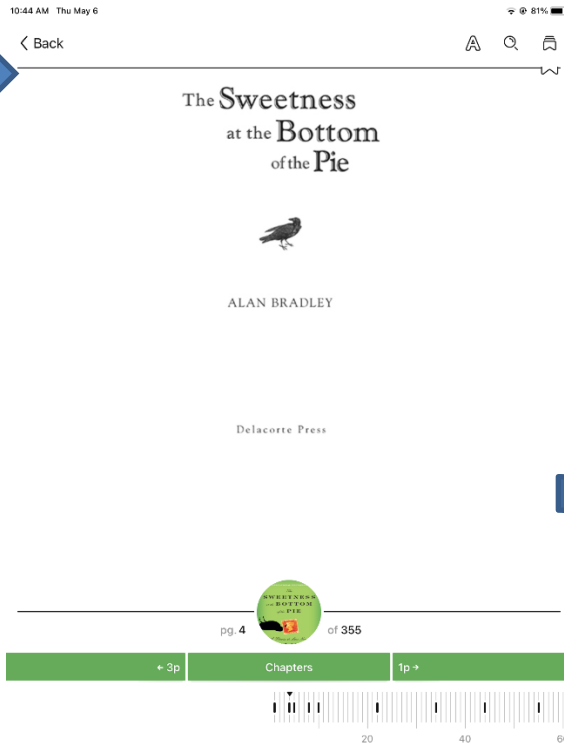
5. Tap **Borrow!**

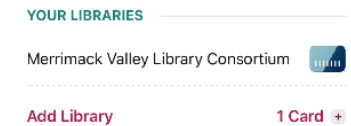
## Adding Another Library

All library consortiums in the state allow you to use your WML card to borrow eBooks from their catalogs. Libby makes it even easier to see which library has what book. Repeat these steps if you want more than two libraries.

1. Tap the **three bars** at the bottom

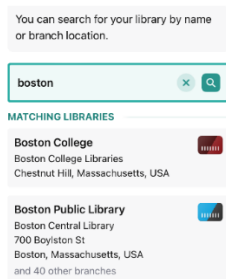


2. Tap **Add Library**

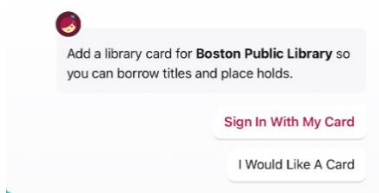


3. Type the **name of the library**

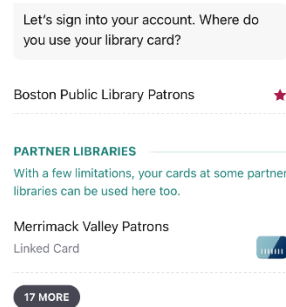
4. Tap the **result**



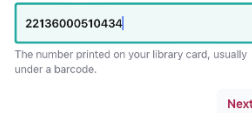
5. Tap **Sign In With My Card**



6. Tap **Merrimack Valley Patrons**

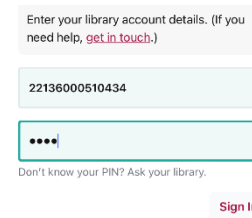

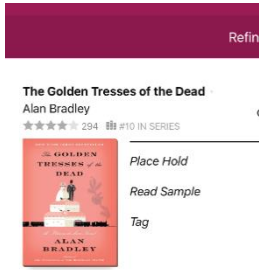

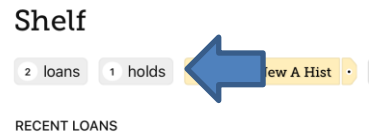
## Canceling a Hold

### 2. Tap the **Holds** tag at the top

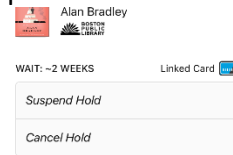

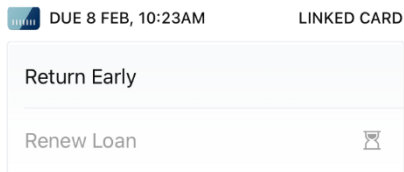
1. Tap **Shelf** at the bottom
