**Director's Report**

The library's new privacy booth had a successful launch, already having been reserved more than 30 times in the past month.

Nathalie attended the Friends Annual Meeting on March 19th. The marketing team did a fantastic job presenting all the different ways to use a library card.

MVLC is currently in the process of getting a new library computer system for all 36 libraries in the consortium. The system is to go live in late spring of 2027. The staff will be getting training on the new system in winter and early spring.

The staff had de-escalation training with Lieutenant Matthew Stavro and Detective Ronald Alpers of the police department during the March staff meeting, as well as a discussion about how to handle a visit from ICE agents. The library is working with the town manager, the police department, and the town IT

department to purchase and install panic buttons for staff around the public services desks, as well as an exterior security camera at the parking lot entrance of the library.

The library's new website redesign is still ongoing, with the launch being sometime in June.

There are almost 4,200 subscribers to the library's newsletter. The tech team had digitized 49 items. And the Connect with a Social Worker office hours has been visited by three patrons.

Youth Services attended the STEM fair at the Middle School with 80 people stopping by the library's booth.

There is also 80 people who have registered for the Behind the Book program featuring author Michael Holley at the Senior Center on May 14.
