Director's Report

Five brand new heat pumps for heat and air conditioning have been installed on second floor of the library. The Banda Room heat pump will be replaced next fiscal year. The director got the directive for Capital Improvements. Nathalie will request first floor heat pump replacements for the next fiscal year. September 17th program "Welcome to Wilmington" was attended by 40 people. There was discussion at the quarterly MVLC's directors meeting about having an increase in the annual membership fee.

September 25th Author Event at the Senior Center was attended by 185 people. The next author event will be on May 14, 2026 with Boston sports writer, journalist and professor Michael Holley.

The new Assistant Childrens Librarian Michelle Carley will be starting October 27th.

The library participated in Fall Fest with 1600 visitors to the Library's table.

Assisted listening system has been installed in the Stewart room for those with hearing issues. This will be promoted in the future.

Erin will be starting a World Language deposit collection that is shared with other libraries. The books change every 90 days.

Erin and others are working on a week's worth of Jane Austen programs celebrating the author's 250th birthday.

Teen program Back to School Bubble Tea party was well attended. New high school class about History of Wilmington met here to see what materials we have and how to access the online information. The library will participate in the Town Tree Lighting on Saturday December 6th.
